It is meant to help researchers to keep abreast with the latest developments in their area of research. For students, the library is a source to get support for their course curriculum as well as for their self-development.

The library is fully automated and is focused on web-based and electronic delivery of information. The entire Library collection is made available through University's network. Library catalogue has been computerized through Libsys Library management software. The library catalogue can also be searched using a common web browser. Users can access the online database from anywhere and find out the real-time availability of library materials.

### **Library Services**

Library services like OPAC (On-line Public Access Catalogue)CAS (Current Awareness Service), Reference and Information Service, Circulation, Display New Arrival, Inter-library Loan service, Digitize Question papers, E-mail alerts are provided.

***Automated Circulation System*** - All the books in library are Bar-coded and the library using Barcode scanner for issue/return of books. Records of all the library patrons have also been created in the Libsys package for circulation of books.

**Digital Library** This section is located on the first floor of the library. Sixteen computers are placed in multimedia room with an internet facility for the students of university for browsing and research purposes.

**Handbook for School of EDUCATION** - Handbook specifically for the faculty and students of SCHOOL OF EDUCATION is prepared and shared. This handbook provides the links to access the journals (subscribed & open access), e-books list and other online resources and databases useful for students & faculty.

**The Braille Books corner** has been created on the ground floor of the central Library. ASU learning resource centre has 115 general reading books for blind students with the software for the the assistance of Divyangian/Disabled.

**Digital repository of thesis and dissertations** for quick and easy browsing. All the theses are uploaded on web OPAC. PhD Thesis is the repository of the scanned copy of all the research work carried out by the university students for Doctoral Degrees. The soft-copy of thesis is uploaded on web OPAC and on SHODHGANGA website.

**The Digital Repository Service -DRS@ASU** captures all the intellectual assets of Apeejay Styta University. This platform enables the ASU community to browse research publications using a web interface, for easy retrieval. It is expected that the repository will evolve as a major source of reference for all Apeejay Styta University publications accessible on the net. PhD Thesis repository is the collection of the scanned copy of all the research work carried out by the university students for Doctoral Degrees.

**Research cell** has been created to establish a research environment, to identify projects from different funding agencies and motivate faculty and students to apply for research projects. It will try to smoothen all project related file movements by suggesting, supporting and creating procedures in the system. It will facilitate the utilization of grants and timely submission of UC/SE. In addition, Research Cell will provide a platform for students and teachers by organizing lectures of eminent personalities, training programmes/workshops and webinars for the upliftment of research.
