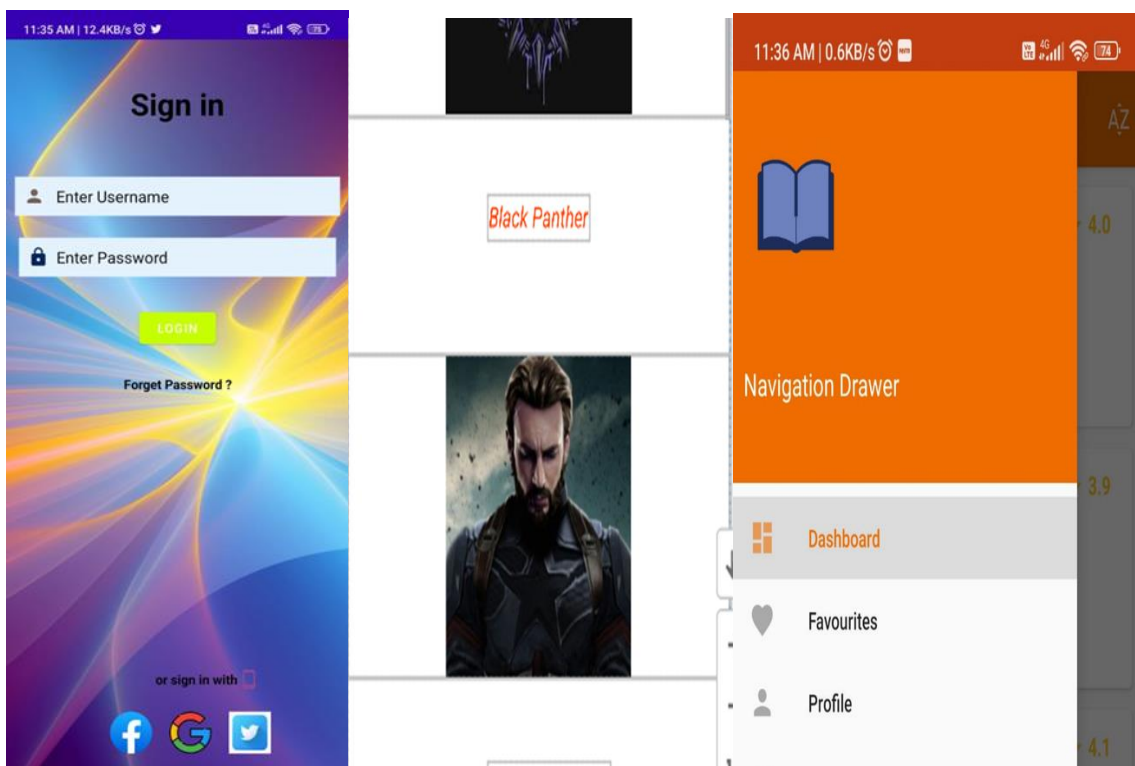
WEEK 2 and 3: Introduction to kotlin and IntelliJ
